CORESS Reporting App is launched:

Great news! The CORESS Reporting App is now available to download and use on your phone. The App makes reporting to CORESS easy and convenient.



- The NEW CORESS App allows easy reporting, in complete confidence, by recording, transcribing, editing, and submitting to CORESS straight from your phone.
- You can submit your report completely anonymously, but if you do identify yourself, we will be able to contact you if there are any queries about your report.
- Every submission is treated in the strictest confidence and when published, will never contain any clues of origin.
- We only keep personal details if you give us permission.



Search for CORESS in the Apple App Store and Google Play:

- Download the App from Apple Store or Google Play
- Record your report or type if you prefer. There is no dictation time limit, recording can be paused and resumed later.
- Make sure 'Low Power Mode' is not selected on your device. [App Store]
- Make sure screen lock is OFF on your device. [Google Play]
- Say 'comma', 'full stop', new paragraph to punctuate your report.
- When recording an incident do not include identifier names

We urge all to use the reporting tool and help others improve patient safety!
